Criteria - Performance will be satisfactory when:

- D.3. you maintain an appropriate distance from class members who are practicing or playing
- D.4. you clear playing court and surrounding area of debris or unneeded equipment

E. Demonstrate badminton physical conditioning

F. Demonstrate badminton etiquette

Criteria - Performance will be satisfactory when:

- F.1. you wait until play is stopped before retrieving a ball from a different court or walking behind that court
- F.2. you keep yourself under control by avoiding disruptive behavior during class
- F.3. you announce score before each point when serving
- F.4. you respect opponent's line judgments
- F.5. you referee game according to badminton rules
